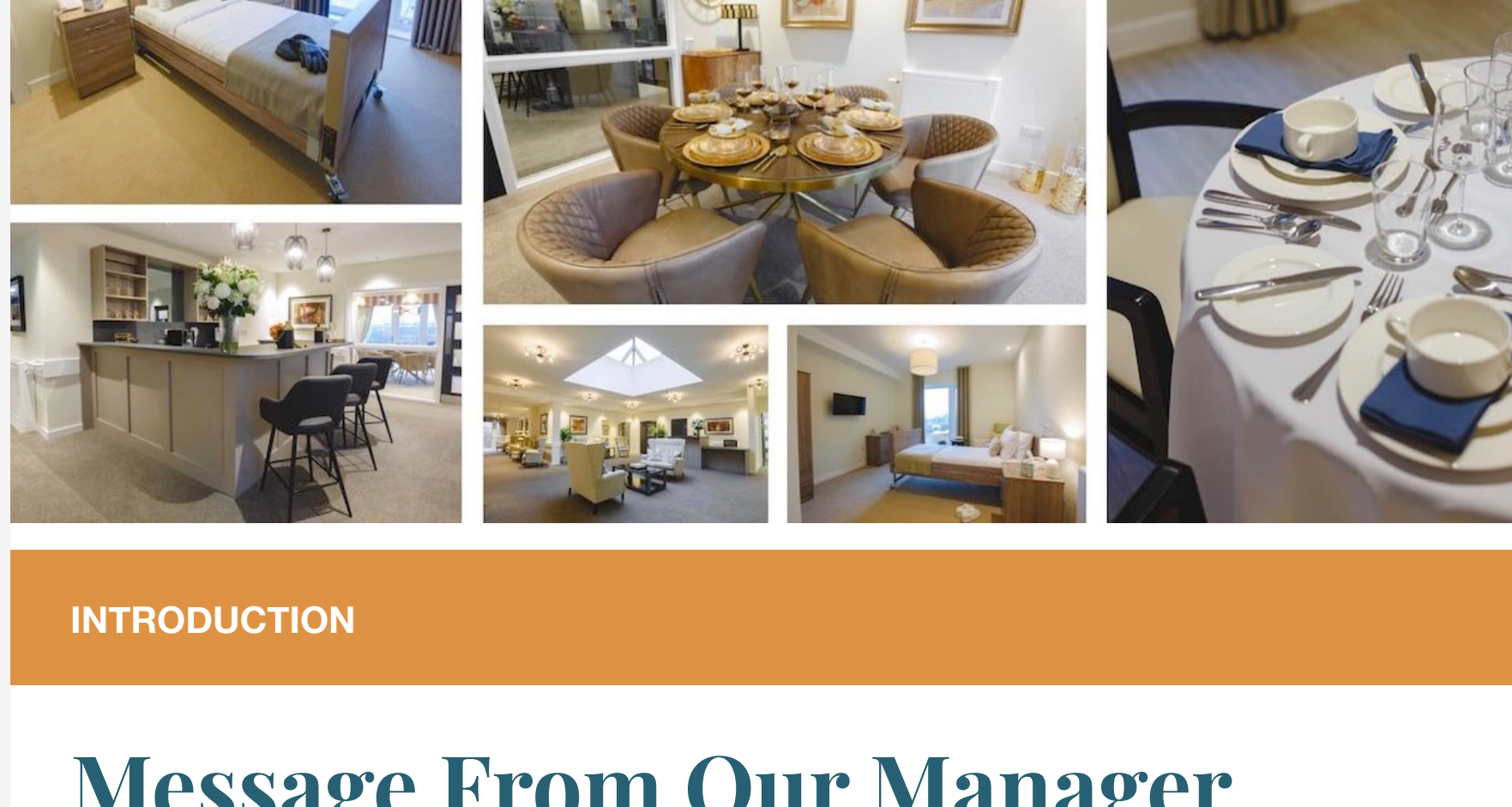




INTRODUCTION

As we look ahead, we remain committed to providing exceptional care, creating meaningful moments for our residents and continuing to make Kingfisher House a place people are proud to call home.

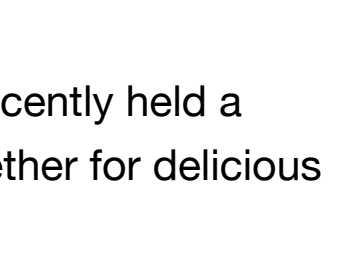
Thank you to everyone who has been part of our journey so far. We are excited to see what the next chapter brings.

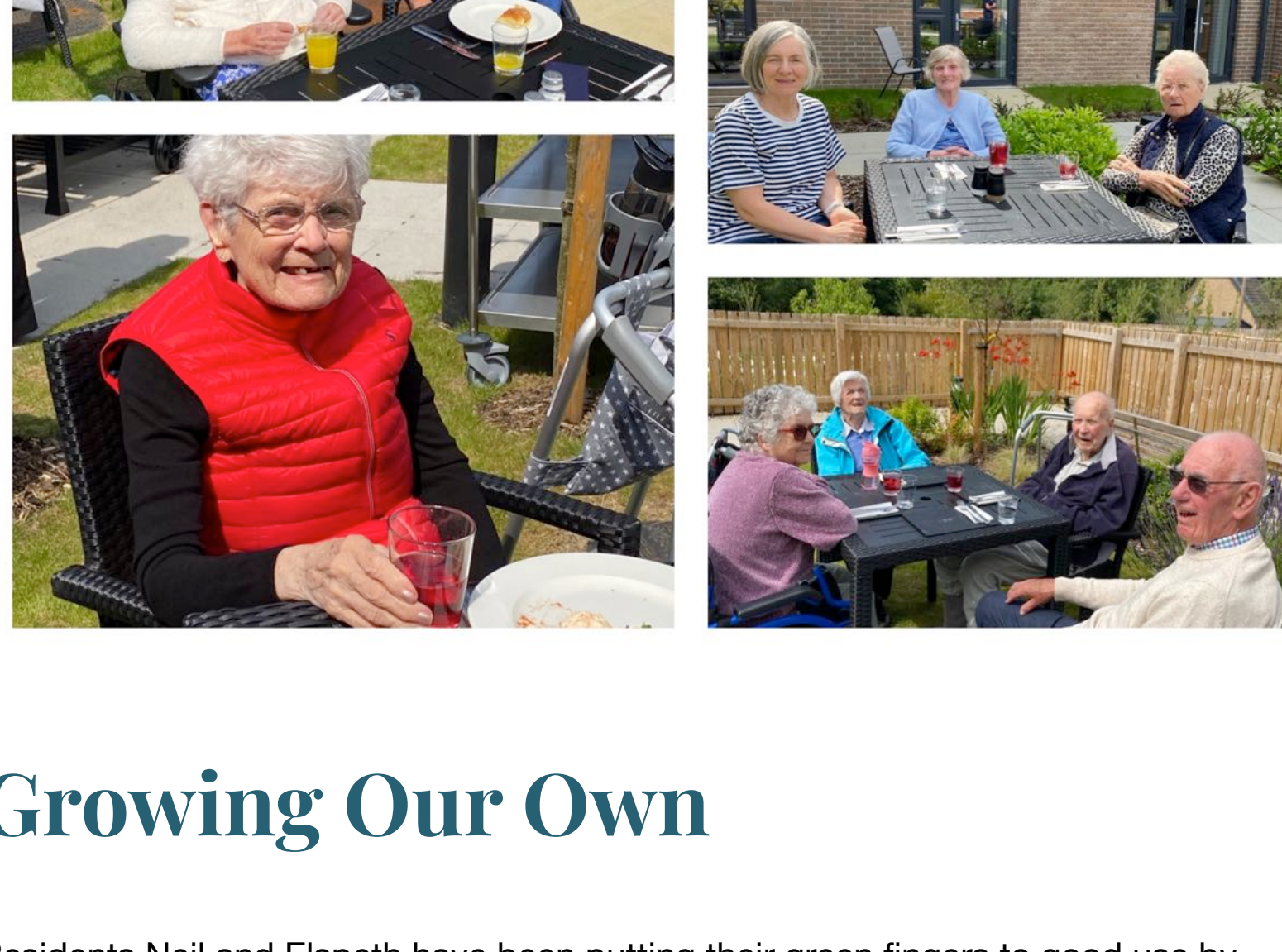
ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

We look forward to many more community outings and memorable experiences in the months ahead.

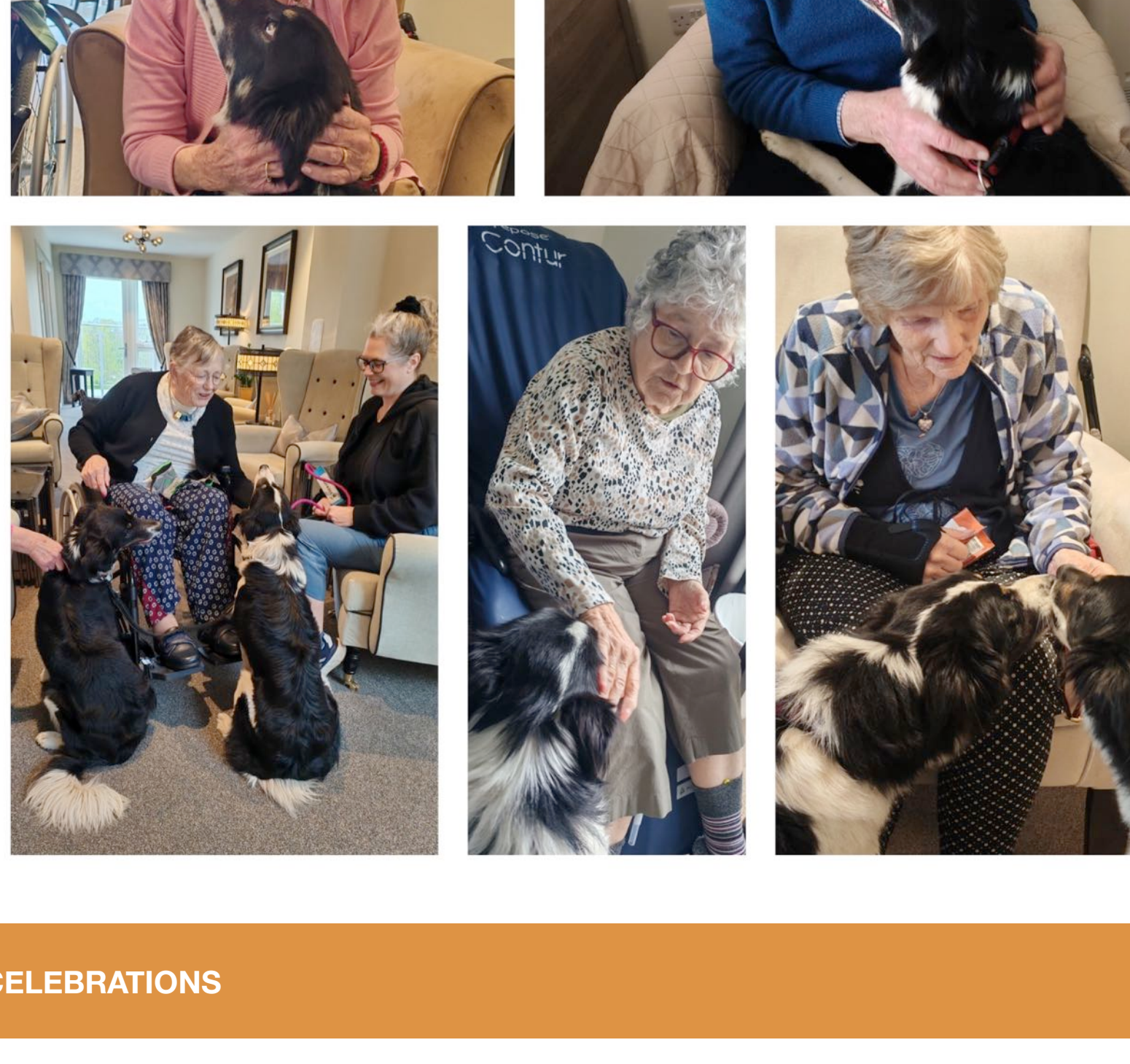


Therapy Dogs Bring Smiles
